Objective	Students will be able to label pictures with inventive spelling.
Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Animal Picture Poster (or displayed on your board)</li><li>Stuffed animals (or photos of animals)</li><li>Label Definition Poster</li></ul>
Lesson	<p><b>Review</b> what labeling means using the label poster and sticky notes how we labeled the teacher yesterday.</p> <p><b>Stuffed Animals Activity:</b> Remind students that labels help to identify something. Display the stuffed animals and have students help you to label each stuffed animal with a sticky note. You can write the words that students provide, or you can have students write the words. Either way demonstrate inventive spelling and assure students that it's okay to write the sounds they hear.</p>
Practice	<p><b>Label the Animals Poster:</b> You can complete this activity on the poster or project the PDF onto your smart board. You can have students complete this or have students volunteer the answers and you write them.</p> <p>Students can complete their worksheet with your whole group or independently for guided practice.</p> <p><b>Journaling:</b> Students can practice labeling one of the picture labeling pages in the journal. They can color the pictures if they have extra time.</p>

## Labeling Lesson 1

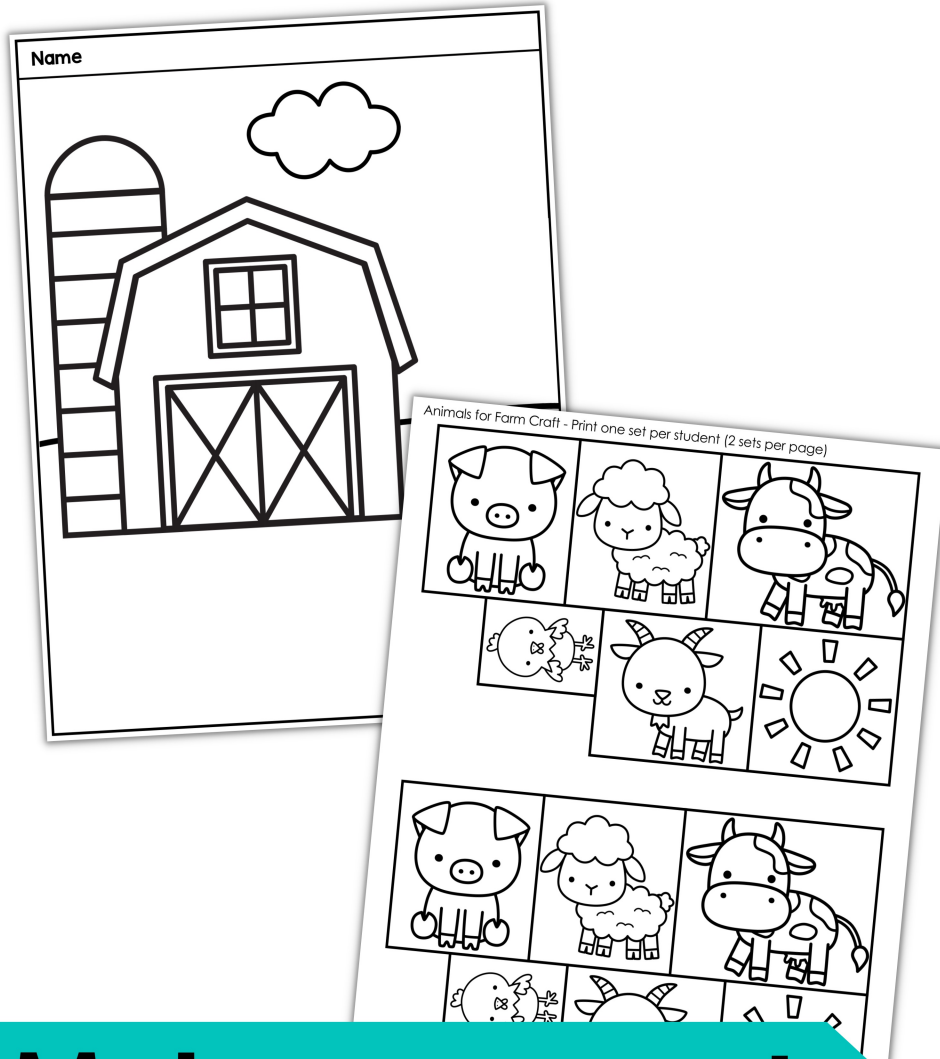
<b>Standard</b>	CCSS.ELA-LITERACY.W.K.2: Use a combination of drawing, dictating, and writing to compose informative/explanatory texts in which they name what they are writing about and supply some information about the topic.
<b>Objective</b>	Students will be able to provide words to label parts of the teacher.
<b>Materials</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sticky Notes</li><li>• Markers</li><li>• Label Definition Poster</li></ul>
<b>Lesson</b>	<p>Talk to students about what labeling means and explain that labeling pictures and photos helps people to know what the picture shows.</p> <p>Display the Labeling Definition Poster – explain that labels are words that tell what is in a picture or photo to help the reader to better understand.</p> <p>Explain that we can label anything. Maybe you have classroom items labeled with picture cards around your room, students can point some of those out.</p>
<b>Practice</b>	<p><b>Label the teacher Activity:</b> Have students help to label you! Use the sticky notes to write the words students share. Then stick the note to you. For example, a student could point out your shoes. You write shoes on a sticky note and stick it to your shoes.</p> <p><b>Extension idea:</b> You may give each student a sticky note and allow them to label on object in the classroom.</p>

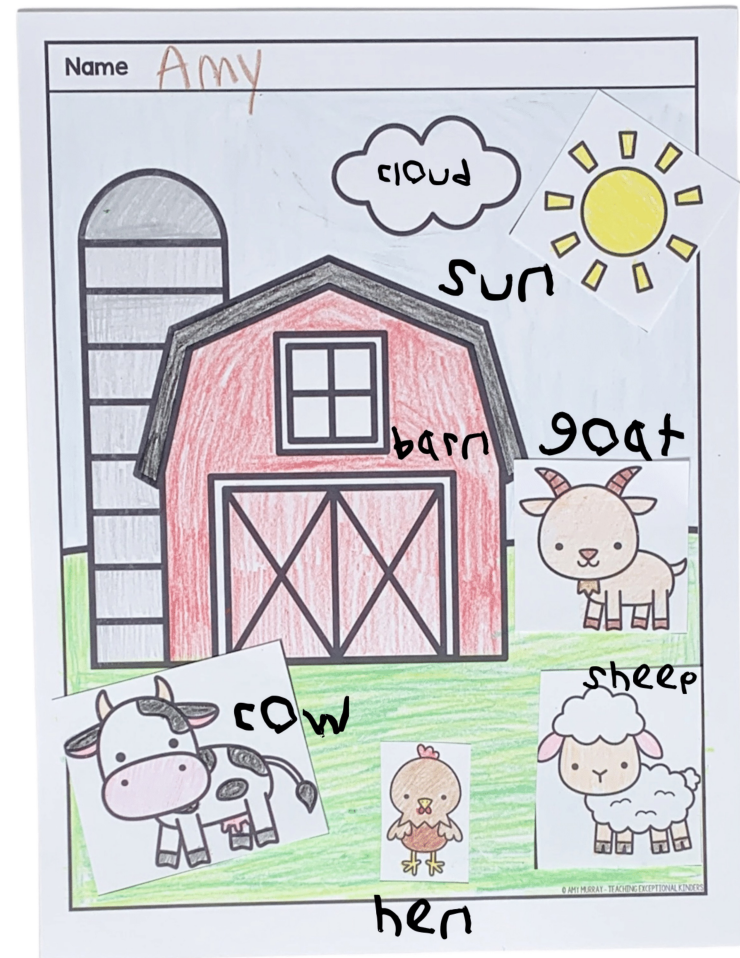




